THE STATUE OF LIBERTY

The Statue of Liberty was completed in 1886. Only six years later, Ellis Island opened as an Immigrants port. More than 12 million immigrants arrived in New York between 1892 and 1954. But first they walked through the golden door of Ellis Island, the „ Island of Hope „.
